### **Timing System – Kurt Schantz**

Rallywest provides support to all events with the timing gear. Deployed at events by Trevor Coughlan 2017 saw normal wear and tear on gear. All times are working, one trip light being fixed. Lost 2 hand held radios, head lamps and stop watches, will need budget to replace.

Large display board confusing, going to investigate if we can do something about.

Investigate the syncing with Rallysafe, think this has happened at 2017 Pacific Forest Rally.

Manage the storing of timing equipment, will need budget and space for spares.
