## Banking and Treasurer Report

Income is down due to lower number of entries. We have \$7200 in the GIC for the Road Damage fund, was noted that during the 2018 AGM we decided to have a minimum of \$5000 in the bank account.

Discussed some of the line items in the budget as they have not been used in a long time. Promotions funds, decided would match funds for promotion up to \$75 per event, to be used towards Facebook ads, spectator ads. Volunteer recognition, this is a Thank you for outstanding volunteers, volunteers who always come and never ask for anything.

Due to CARS new rules most likely will no longer be getting recce speeding fines.  
Bad debt, do we write off, some discussion on what it is and options to collect. We will continue to try and collect. We have a healthy bank account.  
Discussed reducing general levy fee and road damage fee as road damage fund full.

Adam Scrivens motions to drop the general levy fees to \$10 from \$20. Eric Grochowski second. Amendment: Subsequent to funds being at \$5000, if we pay out of fund fees go back to \$20 to rebuild fund. Approve, Abstained Keith and Debbie

Rallywest has made a profit of \$518. It was brought up that Rallywest has a stale dated cheque from CARS from 2018, Debbie will reissue, less administration fees. Also, the Kananaskis Rally has not been invoiced, this will be done shortly.

## **2019 CSCC Rally Director Annual Report**

The Calgary sports car club organized 3 stages and 4 TSDS and 2 test days in 2019. Stage has run with a surplus and TSD has struggled to make money. We do however need to recruit and train more organizers.

### **A breakdown of this year's events.**

#### **STAGE:**

Cochrane Winter Rally was organized by Amanda Ann, Clerked by Keith. 17 started the event and 17 finished.

Our National event The Rocky Mountain Rally ran in Invermere BC, and was organized by Keith Morison, 35 started and 27 finished.

Kananaskis Rally was organized by Chris Heier, clerked by Brad. 16 started and 12 finished.

#### **TSD**

Snowball Rally was organized by me. 8 started and 6 finished

Trail of the Gnu was cancelled due to weather conditions

Loop Rally was organized by me. 6 started and 3 finished

Mudlark Rally was organized by me. 3 started and 3 finished

Hunting of the Snark was organized again by me. 8 started and 7 finished.

### **WCRC Report –**

Rallywest hosts 3 events in Region  
There are 5 events in total for the WCRC championship  
We need to find more organizers; more people need to step up and help out.

Cochrane Winter Rally had 17 entries, with 17 finishing  
Rocky Mountain Rally had 35 entries with 35 starting and 27 finishing  
Kananaskis Rally had 16 Entrants with 16 starting and 12 finishing

Inquiry made about WCRC awards when not given out at CARS banquet. Will investigate WCRC awards banquet costs.

### **Timing System –**

Trevor Coghlan has stepped down.  
Peter Hill is willing to help store and maintain the equipment, but is unable to deploy at events.

The current system is close to the end of its life, we have had the equipment more than 10 years

Noted that some competitors miss the use of starting lights at Pacific Forest Rally and Kananaskis Rally when only RallySafe was used for timing. Drivers cannot always see RallySafe and they had no count down if co-driver is busy.

Do we want to look at what other beam systems are available?

Suggested that RallySafe is the primary system for tracking and timing back up to current system with push button as a third back up.

If we cannot use RallySafe backup needs to beam based over push system, otherwise we are going backwards.

ECM system is no longer supported, timer boxes, beam finish and radio system was built by Peter Hill. Currently manually radio times in when clocks fail. Currently falling apart and aging.

Going to investigate what other system can be used to replace current system and to try to extend the life of the current system

Motion to have RallySafe in WCRC as primary timing system when available.

TSD is not covered by tablets, will need to come up with 3-8 clocks for timing

Motion to purchase 4 tablets from Kurt and 1 from Keith for RallySafe system and look at purchasing 4 more tablets from Panasonic up to \$5000.

Keith to do a proposal if RallySafe tablets up to \$5000. Approved, 2 abstentions

Rate fee of RallySafe and timing

Fees in the East is higher than in the West due to travel, once the East trains people will be cheaper in the future.

Suggested that CARS competition license holders have a permanent full install kits. For those that do not a rental fee of \$50 per event for temporary kits, could be rental fee per piece to give the competitors a chance to purchase without one big hit. Will send this out to competitors in the west.

#### **CARS Board Director Report – Chris Kremer**

The CARS board is reviewing the AWD rules, and minimum weight for O4WD.  
(Opinion, allow Homologated cars R2/R3/R5) Mandated that tracking will be at all National events.  
Looking at efficient scrutineers, there is a high cost but is necessary.

Looking at adding an eighth event to the Canadian championship calendar, Rallye Charlevoix, will be it
